CALL TO ORDER

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

- 1. Consider approval of the following Beautification Commission minutes:**
 - a) May 21, 2012 regular meeting.**

Future projects - Community Gardens, add color to City beds, revive the medians on Harwood - start with removing the dead trees. A sub-committee will work on design to be presented to the City Council. Don Henderson will make available drawings of the medians. The sub-committee meeting to discuss this project will be held Wednesday, June 27th, 7:00 p.m. at the Library.

5. Discuss and possible action of purchasing containers for cigarette butts near the Theatre in Boys Ranch Park.

An outdoor cigarette/trash can is needed at the theater. Don Henderson brought catalogs, one was decided on and Don will place the order.

6. Discuss purchasing shirts for Beautification members.
