**JOB SUMMARY:** Maintains and repairs elements of the water distribution system, such as pipes, lines, valves, fire hydrants, and meters. Operates and services equipment used in the repair and maintenance of the water system. Assist the Crew Leader or Supervisor in maintaining proper job site safety.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- High School Diploma or GED and 3 months related experience and/or training OR equivalent combination of education and experience.
- A valid Texas Driver's License.
- Must be able to perform manual labor in adverse weather conditions.
- Must be able to lift and/or move up to 100 pounds.
- **Preferred:** Texas Class A Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement.
