JOB SUMMARY: Directs and coordinates daily activities of workers engaged in maintaining and repairing physical structures of municipal drainage systems and right-of-ways. Performs small equipment repairs and preventative maintenance for all assigned tools and equipment. Inspects completed work for conformance to specifications and standards.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or GED and 2 years related experience and/or training OR equivalent combination of education and experience.
- A valid Texas Class B Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement.
- Must be able to perform manual labor in adverse weather conditions.
- Must be able to lift and/or move up to 100 pounds.
- **Preferred:** Texas Department of Agriculture Licenses for Vector and Rodent Control.
- *Must obtain a Texas Department of Agriculture License for Vector Control within 6 months of employment.*
- *Must obtain Work Zone Traffic Certification within 1 year of employment.*
