MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

 High School Diploma or GED and 2 years related experience and/or training OR equivalent combination of education and experience.

- Texas Class B Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement.
- Must be able to lift and/or move up to 100 pounds.
- IMSA Signs and Pavement Marking Technician certification and an IMSA Traffic Signal certification.
- Preferred: Texas Class A Commercial Driver's License with tanker endorsement and Confined Space Entry certification.
- Must obtain a Work Zone Traffic Control Certification within 1 year of employment.
