CALL TO ORDER

Marty Geer, Chairperson, called the Commission meeting to order at 6:36 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

- 1. Consider approval of the following Beautification Commission minutes:**
 - a) March 9, 2020 regular meeting**

Kimberly Payne moved that the minutes be approved as written, Bucky Geer seconded. The motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

- 2. Discussion and possible action on KTB Virtual Conference August 25 - 26, 2020.**

The KTB Virtual Conference will be held August 25-26, 2020. If members are interested in participating in the virtual conference, they need to advise Marty Geer. Last year Marty Geer and Karen Jacobsen attended the event.

OLD BUSINESS

- 3. Discussion and possible action on going forward for November 7 date for Bedford KTB Fall Sweep and Great American Cleanup from June 1 to October 18, 2020.**

A discussion was held regarding the Bedford Keep Texas Beautiful Fall Sweep and Great American Cleanup. The actual cleanup dates run from June 1 to October 18, 2020. The BBC had originally set the cleanup date for November 7, 2020. It was decided that there might be additional volunteers/participation if the event was held September 19, through October 18, 2020. By extending the date, small groups would have more flexibility with dates to participate. Small groups could consist of Boy Scout/Girl Scout Troops, families, church groups, HOA's, etc. Marty will contact other Boards and Commissions and invite them to participate in the event. Groups will be responsible for determining the date they will be participating and advise the BBC of the date. The BBC will provide

supplies. Kimberly made a motion to extend the date of the KTB Fall Sweep and Great American Cleanup to run from September 19 through October 18, 2020 and Patty seconded the motion. The motion carried.

4. Discussion and possible action on Bedford Clean-up Park's day on Saturday, June 20, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. at Dewey Tennant Park and August 15, 2020 at City Hall.

Don advised that picnic tables and grills had been installed at Dewey Tennant Park. The park has been cleaned up; therefore, a clean-up day was not needed at this time. The Clean-Up Day scheduled for June 20, 2020, will be at City Hall, Building A beginning at 8:00 am. Dead plants will be removed, pavers will be installed, periwinkles will be planted around the tree, mulch will be spread out, and shrubs will be trimmed. Plantings and mulch will be placed on both sides of BEDFORD City Hall entrance sign on Forest Ridge. The Clean-Up Day for August has been cancelled.

a.) Parks – Boys Ranch Activity Center has been renamed Generations Park. Kelly Snook is the new Project Manager for Phase Next. The Parks and Recreation Board approved \$15,000 for grills/picnic tables/benches for Brookhollow Park.
