To the Citizens of Bedford,

Governor Abbott announced Phase II of the plan to re-open the State of Texas. On May 18, 2020, gyms, exercise facilities, hair salons, barbershops, childcare centers, youth clubs, and personal care businesses (tattoo/piercing studios, massage parlors, laser hair removal, hair loss treatment) were allowed to open, but only at 25% capacity.

As of today, Friday, May 22, restaurants will be allowed to open at 50% occupancy. Bars, breweries, tasting rooms, and similar establishments may open at 25% occupancy. I encourage everyone to be as safe as possible and continue social distancing practices when supporting these businesses. You are making a difference. With the opening of more businesses and the holiday weekend, it is expected that even more people will be out. The Bedford Police Department will continue to serve as the city adopts the new normal.

The Bedford Police Department will be participating in Tarrant County's "No Refusal" Weekend initiative, which means police will be out in force looking for impaired drivers. Start time of 9:30 p.m. on Friday May 22, 2020 through 5:30 a.m. on Tuesday, May 26, 2020.
