


POSTER



YOU WILL EARN 5 HOURS OF COMMUNITY SERVICE FOR EACH WELL EXECUTED POSTER. HOURS WILL BE ASSIGNED AT COORDINATORS DISCRETION, ACCORDING TO HOW WELL YOU FOLLOW THE DIRECTIONS BELOW:

Poster can be created as a digital image, using a poster board, or on printer paper. No lined notebook paper allowed.

Each poster must contain a minimum of four facts or researched data relevant to your offense, without repeating information already stated.

Posters must have a title.

Paper posters must contain artwork and use multiple colors throughout. Colored pencils and crayons are preferred but markers are allowed as long as writing is legible.

Digital posters must contain graphics and illustrations.

We will allow one poster per citation, unless you can come up with a completely different set of images and data for multiple posters.

Posters can be dropped off at the Teen Court office during business hours or submitted electronically. If choosing the poster board or paper option, you must take a clear picture, free of glare, when submitting electronically.
